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## NOTE 1 －TWO WAY CHECKBACK

## NOTE 7 －GAZZILLI

Any strong hand（16＋）by opener，after 1NT forcing or $1 \boldsymbol{\wedge}$ forcing over $\mathbf{1} \boldsymbol{\bullet}$ ，bids $2 \boldsymbol{*}$ ．Maybe a natural bid， any balanced hand or any strong hand．
After $2 \star, 2 \star$ by responder $=9+$ HCP，

## NOTE 8 －1M－2NT

$15+$ HCP balanced．May have 2 to 4 cards in opener suit．
Opener may bid shortness with $6+$ cards．

## NOTE 9 －STAYMAN AND TRANSFERS AFTER 1NT

## STAYMAN

After 2 » $3 \star$ asks for minors and $3 \mathrm{M}=$ smolen
After $2 \star$ » $3 \bullet$ shows a major shortnes
After 2 M » 3 asks for minors and $3 \star$ shows major fit and asks for controls

## SPECIAL AUCTIONS ON COMPETITION

After partner overcall in suit，jump level in a suit under overcall is support with strength below direct cuebid．

Over strong NT » double＝5＋m4M
Over weak NT » transfers overcalls
GOOD－BAD in competitive auctions by opener » $2 \mathrm{NT}=$ zone $2+$ opening bid，Direct suit just for competition．

Rubensohl after overcall over 1NT
2NT scrambling in competition．
