

DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING
OVERCALLS (Style: Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)
On minor: 2D: 2 suiter majors, 2NT: 2 lowest suits
Jump overcall: weak (can sometimes even be zero points)
1NT: 15-17
Rest natural
Reopenings: suit max 13 points, 1NT: 10-13, DBL Opening hand (or 4441/4443 in other suits 7+), jump suit weak (can be zero points)
1NT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)
2nd:15-17, responses as per system
4 th : 2 other suits with longer cards in lower suit
Reopening: 10-13, answers natural weak or cuebid if strong
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
As per above
Reopen: As per above
DIRECT & JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)
Direct: fit in partners major or strong hand in certain sequences
Jump: ask for stopper to play NT
2-suiter Cue-bids as per overcalls explanation
VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening;PH)
Strong: Multilandy + Dbl: 5+Minor and 4 card Major
Weak: Multilandy + DBL opening values or more (including multilandy distributions you don't want to bid in Multilandy)
VS.PREEMTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)
On weak 2 majors: 4cl and 4 diamonds: 2 suiter with the bid minor
And the other major
Rest Natural
